

<u>Fujian Culture and Outdoors Itinerary for ISD Dongguan</u> (G8-G12)



Location: Xiamen / Yunshuiyao, Fujian (福建厦门, 云水谣)

Dates: November 18-22, 2019

Overview: Our itinerary will involve a variety of different activities in Fujian Province. 2 days will be spent in Yunshuiyao Scenic Area, whose landscape is dominated by the unique "Tulou" dwellings. Students will learn about the Hakka culture through participatory EOTC experiences and supporting materials, as well as through hikes and a bike ride. The other half of the trip will be spent in and around the city of Xiamen, doing cultural and outdoor activities, including a scavenger hunt on Gulangyu Island and a via ferrata course.

Accommodation: Tulou guesthouse (2 nights), Urban Hotel (1 Night), Dorm Accommodation (1 night), Hot Springs (1 night): ensuite twin rooms for students, ensuite private rooms for teachers

Program Highlights



Hakka "Tulou" Roundhouses: Beginning as early as the 12^{th} century, the people of southern Fujian first built communal strongholds on top of mountains, which ultimately evolved into so-called Tulou (土楼) earth dwellings. While they are commonly associated with the Hakka, they were actually utilized by all people in the area. Students will spend two nights in an old tulou that has been converted into a guesthouse. They will get a chance to see a variety of tulous in their original condition (on foot and on

two wheels), and even help restore one as part of a community service project.

Oolong Tea Culture: Oolong (乌龙) is a traditional Chinese tea that originated in Fujian province. Just as varying fermentation processes produce different wines, tealeaves are processed in different ways to develop into three distinctive types of tea: Green, Oolong and Black. This process was developed in China during the Ming Dynasty (1368-1644 AD). Chinese growers were challenged to preserve the delicate qualities of tea while it was shipped on long



journeys (to Europe) as it was becoming an important commodity. Students will learn all about Oolong tea, by hiking into the mountains to pick it, followed by processing and tasting!



Via Ferrata & Zipline: A via ferrata (Italian for "iron road" is a protected climbing route found in the Alps and certain other locations. The essence of a modern via ferrata is a steel cable which runs along the route and is periodically (every 3 to 10 meters) fixed to the rock. Using a via ferrata kit, climbers can secure themselves to the cable, limiting any fall. As part of the trip, students will have the opportunity to

complete a via ferrata cour forested mountains outside





Xiamen: Gulangyu Scavenger Hunt: The trip will conclude in the city of Xiamen, specifically on Gulangyu Island, whose well preserved buildings stand in stark contrast to the rest of the city, which is modernizing rapidly. We will experience some of the different cultural forces that shaped the architecture and history of Xiamen by doing a cultural scavenger hunt. The activity will also involve a DIY lunch, and free time for exploring and souvenir shopping.



Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive / Hike / Zengcuo'an Night Market

9:30am-1:30pm: High-speed train from Shenzhen to

Xiamen:

- 1:30pm: Arrive, rendezvous with KA guides, introduction snack.
- 2:30pm: Team-building games in nearby park or brief hike in the hills above Nanputuo Temple.
- 6:30pm: Transfer to *zengcuo 'an* pedestrian area for DIY dinner and free time.
- 8:30pm: Transfer to hotel, check-in









Day 2: Scavenger Hunt on Gulangyu / Transfer to Xiaohuangshan / Bonfire

7:30am: Breakfast at hotel, check-out 8:30am: Transfer to pier, ferry to Gulangyu Island 9:00am: Educational scavenger hunt, which will enable

the students learn about its history, with free time to explore the island.

- 12:00pm: DIY lunch on Gulangyu Island or in nearby restaurant, followed by return ferry to Xiamen
- 2:00pm: Conclude activities, return ferry, transfer to Xiaohuangshan
- 4:00pm: Check into on-site guestrooms (dormitory- style), shower, rest

6:30pm: BBQ dinner

7:30pm: Bonfire, evening games

Day 3: Via Ferrata and Zipline / Transfer to Yunshuiyao

8:30am: Breakfast at on-site restaurant, check-out

- 9:30am: Brief hike, followed by zipline and via ferrata course, with cables, ladders, and bridges.
- 1:00pm: Lunch in on-site restaurant













- 2:00pm: Bus to Yunshuiyao Village (云水谣), location of several clusters of UNESCO Tulou earth dwellings, each of which can house 50 families and which form the focal point of Hakka society.
- 5:00pm: Check into guesthouse, inside of a real tulou, discussion of tulou history and culture

6:00pm: Dinner, introduction to tulou history









Day 3: Bike Ride / Community Service Project / Hakka Puppet Show

- 8:30am: Breakfast at guesthouse
- 9:00am: Group A: Advanced biking group: distribute bikes and helmets, safety briefing, begin bike ride

Group B: Transfer to dilapidated tulou, begin community service project (repairing tulou)

12:00pm: "Local flavor" lunch in tulou area, rest

- 1:00pm: Switch groups/activities (beginner cycling group)
- 4:30pm: Conclude activities, return to guesthouse, discussion of community service, prepare for puppet show.
- 6:00pm: Dinner in nearby restaurant
- 7:30pm: Traditional Fujian puppet show, performed by Hakka puppeteers. Afterwards, students will take turns acting out their own scenes.











Day 5: Hike / Post-card Making / Tea Culture / Hot Springs

8:30am: On-site breakfast

- 12:30pm: Hike to local Oolong tea Plantation for lesson in tea culture, including tea picking
- 4:30pm: Conclude hike, return to base.
- 5:00pm: Learn about tea processing, sample







Oolong Tea 6:00pm: Return to guesthouse for shower and rest, 7:00pm: Dinner





活动介绍

客家土楼建筑:从12世纪开始,闽南人民首先在山上建立了公共 据点,最终演变成今天所谓的土楼住宅。虽然它们通常与客家人 有关,但实际上他们被该地区的所有人使用。学生们将会在已经 改建为民宿的旧土楼上度过两晚。他们将有机会看到原始状态下 的各种土楼(徒步和骑自行车),甚至帮助恢复其中一处土楼作 为社区服务项目的一部分。

乌龙茶文化:乌龙(乌龙)是一种传统的中国茶,发源于福建省。 正如不同的发酵 过程产生不同的葡萄酒一样,茶叶以不同的方式 加工成三种不同类型的茶:绿茶,乌龙茶和红茶。这个过程是在 明朝(公元 1368-1644)在中国发展起来的。由于中国种植者致 力于保存技术使其成为一种重要的商品,目的是运输到欧洲等地。 学生们将学习乌龙茶的所有知识,徒步进入山区采摘,然后加工 和品尝!





铁索攀岩及高空滑索:现代攀岩的本质是钢缆设立在攀登 的路

线,并每3至10米固定在岩石上。使用钢缆套件,登山 者可以将自己固定在缆绳上,限制任何坠落。作为旅行 的一部分,学生将有机会在厦门外的一个森林中完成一 个铁索攀岩课程和一个高空滑索。



厦门鼓浪屿寻宝:这次旅行将在厦门市鼓浪屿结束,其保 存完好

的建筑与城市的其他地方形成鲜明对比,厦门正在迈 现代化快速发展。我们将通过文化寻宝活动来体验一 些塑造厦门建筑和历史的不同文化力量。活动还包括 DIY 午餐,以及探索和纪念购物的空闲时间。
