The International School of Dongguan (ISD) was founded in 2012 to serve the educational needs of expatriate and dual-citizenship families residing in Dongguan, Guangdong, Southern China. Originally a Pre-K to Grade 10 school, ISD has grown rapidly and now offers a full Pre-K to Grade 12 program. The current student enrollment is 293 (including 59 students in grades 9-12); The class of 2025 represents our twelfth graduating class and the nineth International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) cohort.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

ISD students earn 1 Carnegie credit for each full-time 2 semester course completed and a 0.5 credit for any single semester course completed successfully. All U.S. universities recognize Carnegie credits as representation of work completed by a student. The class of 2025 must earn 27 credits to earn an ISD diploma. The number of credits fulfills or exceeds most university admission requirements in the U.S.A.
